LEARN TO SAIL

Book a course at EASI/MYC where they will arrange group lessons or private tuition. EASI/MYC has more than 30 boats to choose from and has the ability to teach and train people to a standard where they can sail safely and even do competative racing in small boats.

BASIC SAILING COURSE

This teaches people to understand sailing and their boats, the course is 12 hours sailing tuition and can be completed in a number of ways.

You will learn how to rig and de-rig your boat, how to launch and recover your boat and how to control your boat whilst on the water.

This course may be taken individually or it may be taken in a class situation. Classes may not be larger than three students and they must attend.

Courses can be scheduled for the individual or for a group of two adults or six children (under 12yrs) The training is done in either wayfarer or Bosun dinghies for adults and for children we use Topper Taz boats. The adults have two in a boat plus the instructor and depending on your choice you may either schedule your own course or follow the instruction procedure by the training centre. You must achieve a minimum of 16hrs sailing to complete the course.

ADVANCED SAILING COURSE

Students must have already passed a basic course to attend an advanced training session. It is recommended that they study up on their last course and put in a few hours training before taking this course. They will be taught rigging techniques for improved sailing and depending on their abilities will be taken out in performance boats to learn more about boat handling in racing situations.

KEELBOAT SAILING COURSE

Students do not need to have passed a dinghy course to attend this course. Keel boats are much more stable and easier to sail than dinghies. Sailing these boats takes less actual practice than dinghies however the background knowledge of sailing this type of boat is much more important as most keel boats operate both inshore and off shore. The recommended instruction time required to be a competent basic sailor is 16hrs training.

Advanced sailing requires another 16hrs intensive training and a open mind that allows you to learn each and every time you go out on the water the rest of your life.

- Race techniques

KEELBOAT SAILING COURSE

Keelboat sailing is a course using a more stable boat and it is a prequel to sailing larger yachts, it is a course designed for persons over 16yrs of age and incorporates quite a large amount of technical knowledge. The course maximum is 10 people and a full course is three days to intreprete the information and turn it into action on the water.

A minimum of 16hrs must be completed to finish the course. Course cost per person KSH 30,000 (the course must be completed within three months.)

WEEKENDER COURSE

This is a crash course to cram all the information into a three day period, it will include all that is required and all students MUST be resident unless they live locally.





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
